MDH Updates

- Jim informed the Council that the appointment and re-appointment procedure has been changed by the Secretary of State and the MDH Commissioner's Office.
- Matt Finkenbiner informed the Council that the REHS/RS Registration Program was still waiting on background Financial Management work to be completed on the new E-Licensing System before it could be promoted. He expected February 2024 UA testing. MDH will be asking for external partners to help with testing of the new system in February or March of 2024. Lynn will ask City of Bloomington staff to help with UA testing. Matt let the Council know that all currently registered sanitarians will be assigned new numbers. Matt stated the goal for launch is April or May of 2024. Applicants will be printing their own credential. Duane Hudson asked about a communication plan for the current Registered Sanitarians regarding all of the changes that will be happening. There will be information with links and instructions on the renewals mailed out.
- Jim talked about the new Executive Order implemented by the Governor's office. State Departments can diversify their hiring, diversify who is applying and who can meet credential requirements. This is just for state jobs and does not supersede the requirements for city or county jobs. Linda stated the credentialing in rule or statute is not totally affected by this executive order.
- Jim announced he will be retiring in June 2024 and Christian Kraemer will be taking over as Coordinator of the Council.
