


# Identifying Environmental Wells/Temporary Borings and Determining Administrative Requirements



\*\*An environmental well site includes the environmental wells on a single property. A single property is considered one tax parcel or multiple contiguous parcels with the same owner.

Notification or Record	Temporary Boring is Greater Than or Equal to 25 Feet in Depth	Temporary Boring is Less Than 25 Feet in Depth
