# **Discussion: Organizational Competencies**

### Our takeaways:

#### Leadership

- We need transcendent (or adaptive) leadership, with a focus on leadership within individuals' expertise
- Policy related leadership may be at the local, but more likely the state level (or at least the technical assistance for policy development and support)
- Leadership requires facilitation skills, particularly for navigating conflict and differing priorities, as well as driving to consensus

#### **Technology**

- Need clarity around which data is public and which is confidential
- Challenges and confusion around AI policies and how to bring external partners into shared workspaces

#### **Workforce Development**

- Striving to make sure the workforce is representative of the communities being service, but still a challenge to attract people with diverse backgrounds (what about working with workforce services?)
- Funding streams and grant management can present challenges to consistently recruit and retain staff
- Thinking about training opportunities/employment pathways for mid-career professionals
- Need an overall plan and strategy for workforce development

#### **Financial Management/Facilities**

- Braiding funding for sustainability and resiliency
- Need increased funding that is consistent, sustainable, and directed at primary prevention

#### **Legal Services**

 Opportunity and challenge to work with local governments or county attorneys – they don't always understand public health perspective and PH business needs
