REFUGEE HEALTH PROGRAM

A brief overview of the role of the civil surgeon and a list of USCIS-designated medical providers in Minnesota who can sign off on the I-693 medical exam.

Disclaimer: MDH is not involved in the federal process that designates providers as USCIS Civil Surgeons. Individuals should confirm that a provider is a USCIS-designated Civil Surgeon before scheduling their I-693 medical exam.

Understanding the Role of the Civil Surgeon and Adjustment of Status for Refugees

Immigrants who have been in the U.S. for one year may complete medical evaluations to adjust their status and obtain a “Green Card” or Lawful Permanent Residence status. The medical evaluation requirements are different for refugees and immigrants, so it is important to first determine whether the individual is designated as a refugee or an immigrant. In most cases your patient will know their designation. If they do not know, ask to see their I-94 card. As a general rule, a refugee will have the word "refugee" printed on their I-94 card.

USCIS has also granted local health departments a blanket civil surgeon designation. Medical directors of participating local public health departments may complete the form for applicants with refugee status only. For all applicants, the USCIS Form I-693 must be completed, signed, and submitted in a sealed envelope.

Validity of the I-693 Form

The applicant must submit the I-693 with Form I-485. The form, then, remains valid indefinitely while the USCIS adjudicates the application. Forms that are completed incorrectly are invalid and the application will be rejected.

Key reminders for civil surgeons and public health department staff are listed below. Note this list is **not** comprehensive of I-693 instructions.

- The vaccination form is a common source of errors. Review instructions carefully and ensure all required fields are checked on the vaccine form.
- All pages of the I-693 must be submitted, even those that are intentionally left blank.
- All pages of the I-693 must have the name and A-number header completed, even those pages that are otherwise intentionally left blank.
- The applicant, civil surgeon, preparer (if appropriate), and interpreter (if appropriate) must sign and provide all requested information. Parents signing for children under 14 must sign their own name (not their child’s name).
- Write the signature date on the outside of the envelope of sealed copy of I-693 form, to facilitate the client or lawyer in correct processing. Consider providing client with an extra (unsealed) copy for their records.

For Refugees and Derivative Asylees

- For refugees and derivative asylees who arrived in the U.S. **with** a Class A condition (note: this is unusual), **the entire immigration medical exam is required**, including any necessary vaccinations. In this case, a civil surgeon must complete the exam.
- For refugees who arrived in the U.S. **without** a Class A condition, **only immunizations** need to be reviewed and updated. In this case, a civil surgeon or the medical director of local public health in participating counties may complete the exam.
- Refugees and derivative asylees who only need to submit the vaccination record should submit **the entire Form I-693**, but only certain sections need to be filled out.  - Civil Surgeon's Contact Information, Certification, and Signature
 - Vaccination Record
- Note: derivative asylees need to complete their I-693 exam with a civil surgeon.

Asylees Granted in the U.S. and Parolees

- **A complete medical examination including immunizations is required.**
- The exam must be completed by a civil surgeon (a physician officially designated by USCIS).

For Afghan Humanitarian Parolees

Afghan evacuees who entered the U.S. under humanitarian parole during [Operation Allies Welcome \(www.dhs.gov/allieswelcome\)](http://www.dhs.gov/allieswelcome) have temporary parole status that allows them to legally live and work in the U.S. for two years. To stay longer than two years, they need to file for an adjustment of immigration status through one of these pathways:

- **Special Immigrant Visa (SIV):** Afghan evacuees may qualify for an SIV if they were employed by the U.S. government, U.S. contractor, or International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) in Afghanistan for over a year. - **Asylum:** Afghan evacuees, ineligible for SIV status, may qualify for asylum. This application needs to be filed within one year of arrival, and they may apply for permanent residency after one year from the time asylum was granted. Evacuees who arrived during Operation Allies Welcome may have received a full medical exam by blanket-designated civil surgeons on government-run facilities in the U.S. or abroad. If the medical results were documented on the I-693 immigration medical examination form, or DS-7794 or DS-2054 abroad, this exam will qualify for their adjustment of status application. However, Afghan nationals with an SIV or asylum status

should consult with USCIS and/or legal counsel to determine when and if the I-693 medical examination is required for the adjustment of status to become legal permanent residents.

For Other Immigrants

- **A complete medical examination including immunizations is required.**
- The exam must be completed by a civil surgeon (a physician officially designated by USCIS).

Considerations from Technical Instructions

Tuberculosis Screening

Tuberculosis screening applies to all non-refugee immigrants or refugees who arrived with a Class A waiver. **All applicants 2 years or older MUST have an IGRA TB test (not a TST).** Positive IGRAs, applicants with known HIV infection, and those with signs or symptoms of TB disease must also have a chest x-ray. Lead shielding is no longer recommended or required for the status adjustment medical examination for any applicants, including those who are pregnant.

Per March 2023 Technical Instructions, civil surgeons **should report all Class B0, B1 pulmonary or extrapulmonary, and Class B2 latent TB Infection diagnoses** to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's **eMedical** system. All records must be entered into eMedical within five business days after I-693 forms have been completed. While a release of information is not needed, patients should be informed of this referral. The Minnesota Department of Health and local public health departments will be notified of applicants eligible for latent TB infection management; public health departments may contact the individuals to offer treatment.

Vaccinations

All applicants must meet vaccination requirements for the list of diseases designated by the Centers for Disease Prevention and Control for adjustment of status purposes. This is a subset of the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP) guidelines, and ACIP guidance should be followed regarding age, dosage, timing, and contraindications. As completion of a vaccine series often requires several months, the series may not be complete at the time of I-693 completion. Applicants are required to receive at least one dose of each age-appropriate vaccine listed in Table 1 for which the applicant is not currently up to date. Applicants should be encouraged to follow up with a primary health care provider to complete the other vaccine series.

To avoid high out-of-pocket expenses, applicants with insurance may go to their own primary clinic to complete or update immunizations prior to contacting a civil surgeon. For uninsured applicants, immunizations may be available at a lower cost at the local public health agency in the county in which they reside. **NOTE: Prices may vary among clinics.**
