## **Receipt of Specimens and Lab Testing at MDH-PHL:**

MDH-PHL will be closed for most routine laboratory testing on President's Day (Monday, February 17). However, the following will apply:

- 1. The MDH-PHL Specimen Receiving Area will be open to receive samples on Monday (2/17) from 8:00 am-12:00 pm.
- 2. MDH Newborn Screening Laboratory staff will be performing testing on Monday (2/17).
- 3. Rabies specimens will not be received, and rabies testing will not be performed on Monday (2/17). Please hold all rabies specimens at your facility and send Tuesday (2/18).
