Strategic plan discussion

Background: last October at our WIC Advisory Group meeting, we created a strategic plan for the next 3-5 years. We developed vision elements and identified strategies. We prioritized the strategies and noted other important actions.

Kate shared a PowerPoint and reviewed the top and second tier strategies and what we are currently doing in each area. We broke into small groups to discuss items that were not prioritized as top or second tier strategies but were listed as other action items. Each group had four actions to discuss. The goal was to discuss two of the four action items and answer four questions. The four questions were what the topic was about, why is it important, what are the challenges, and what could the state and local agencies do to advance the strategy. Advisory group will periodically review the strategic plan over the next 3-5 years to see how we continue to advance the vision together and keep identified items prioritized.

MA/WIC text message

Follow-up on spreading out beyond five weeks. This was discussed at April meeting. MA/WIC texts go out on the first Monday in February, May, August, November. It was proposed to shift it to help control the cycle of new applicants.

In 2025 we will explore if we can shift it to a January, April, July, and October schedule.

A text would also go out in December 2025 and for 2026 it would be February, May, August, November again. Tina will ask Joni to see if she is able to request the data from DHS at any time or how it works.

Hemoglobin policy language review follow-up

This was a follow up from our April meeting. Reviewed and discussed adding in a possible 3rd reason of safety (in addition to religious and medical) to the exceptions to required hematological measurements. Rebecca will draft and share with teams.
