- Describe your partnership with a community organization and/or cultural/local/regional breastfeeding coalition and how your proposal will prioritize leadership from the BIPOC community.
- 4. Describe how you will evaluate your project or activity.
- 5. Total amount requested and budget include an itemized budget.
