Policy Updates

- Pasteurized Human Donor Milk Coverage
 - Covered for babies birth through 12 months
 - Must be Medically Necessary
 - Milk Must come from a Human Milk Bank Association of America accredited Milk Bank
 - Still working to get enrolled providers to provide

Lactation Policy

- Visits and Classes are covered
- Medical Assistance covers them when provided by one of the following:
 - Certified lactation educator
 - Certified lactation counselors
 - Indigenous lactation counselors
 - International Board-Certified Lactation Consultants or
 - other health educators with training in lactation
- Breast Pump Coverage and Supplies
 - One electric breast pump is covered per pregnancy (upgrades are not covered)
 - Supplies are covered which can include:
 - Milk storage bags
 - Replacement parts

How to find providers for any of these services or supplies?

Minnesota Health Care Programs Provider Directory

- Check with people or groups in your community, who do they use?
- If you need help getting someone registered as a Durable Medical Equipment Provider (for Breast pumps and supplies) e-mail me: <u>megan.warfield-kimball@state.mn.us</u>
- Once enrolled with Minnesota Health Care Programs, they need to contract with managed care organizations in order to bill them.
