New developments for wichealth.org!

<u>Wichealth.org</u> continues to expand and grow. Many new features have been added for participants and staff.

What is wichealth.org?

- Wichealth.org is a resource available for WIC staff and participants.
 - For Participants: wichealth.org includes many nutrition education lessons geared toward pregnant and breastfeeding participants as well as resources for parents and caregivers of infants and children. Wichealth.org allows participants to complete nutrition education on their own time from anywhere they have access to the internet. Each nutrition lesson is tailored to the individual based on their interests and willingness to implement changes.
 - **For WIC Staff:** The <u>wichealthsupport.org</u> site has an extensive database of information and resources for staff.
 - The "Academy" provides information about wichealth including how to use, promote, and integrate it into daily workflow.
 - Staff can access evaluation and data reports and get answers to their commonly asked questions.
 - The site includes many nutrition education resources for staff and participants.

How to learn about the new features of wichealth.org

- Read future WIC Weekly Updates with in-depth information about each of the new features available on <u>wichealth.org</u> and <u>wichealthsupport.org</u>. Some upcoming highlights:
 - "Wichealth to gos" educational materials staff can text or email participants.
 - A new dashboard where staff can save or "favorite" items and compile education resources to share with participants in the future.

Get Access to wichealthsupport.org

- Request access to <u>wichealthsupport.org</u> in just a few steps!
 - Send an email to <u>help@wichealth.org</u> to request access to the <u>wichealthsupport.org</u> website. Include in the email:
 - Your email address. Use your agency email address, not a personal email address.
 - State name.
 - Agency name. For multi-county agencies, list all counties in your agency.
 - Specify you want "local rep" access.
 - Even if you are NOT planning to offer <u>wichealth.org</u> as an educational resource to participants at this time, you can still access and use the many resources once you have a wichealthsupport.org account. As a bonus, the <u>wichealthsupport.org</u> website provides staff access to the participant site, <u>wichealth.org</u>, so you can check out the many participant lessons!
