

WIC Staff Training- Topic of the Month

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Training is one of the most important functions in establishing and maintaining a quality public health program like WIC. Obtaining the knowledge and skills necessary to provide individualized services to our WIC participants takes time and ongoing effort. There are many resources to ensure that staff are training appropriately and have opportunity for continued support. This month we will focus on those resources, and how to use them to support staff development in broadening their knowledge and competencies in various WIC related topics.

Staff Training Policy

<u>Section 4.5: Staff Training</u> of the <u>Minnesota Operations Manual (MOM)</u> outlines the WIC Staff Training Policy. This policy helps to identify the required training needs based on the staff member's role in WIC. It also provides guidance for evaluating staff needs and documenting training and development that have been completed. Following the requirements and recommendation in MOM Section 4.5 will help ensure that all staff are meeting the expectations of providing competent and quality WIC services.

New Staff Training Guide

The <u>WIC New Staff Training</u> (NST) is a comprehensive outline that provides resources and tools for training and staff development. The guide is broken down into four phases with training recommendations based on the **staff members role** within WIC. The guide is intended for use by a new staff member along with their preceptor (trainer), but seasoned staff may find it a valuable tool for continuing education as well. The NST is updated regularly and includes Minnesota WIC developed trainings as well as materials developed from other sources.

NOTE: Agencies that use their own training plan must cover all topics included in the state NST. If you have questions about your agency's training, consult your State Consultant.

Annual Training Requirements

All staff must complete **Civil Rights** and **WIC Information System Security** training annually. This assures staff are in compliance with the most current requirements. The <u>Required Annually</u> training breaks down the annual training requirements based on the staff member's role at WIC.

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There is a variety of tools available on the <u>WIC Local Agencies</u> page that will support training needs. Here we will highlight a few from each training section.

- The <u>Continuing Education Overview</u> webpage will support the assessment and planning for raining needs.
 - <u>WIC Staff Survey of Training Needs (WORD)</u> is a self-assessment tool for staff to identify areas for additional training and development.
- <u>WIC Nutrition Continuing Education</u> is essential to staff development that broadens skills and expands knowledge. This resource provides many tools to support staff development, identify staff training needs, and document trainings that have been completed.
 - If staff are looking for continuing education resources, they will find a list of current on demand learning, live trainings registrations and a save the date for future topics.
 - Staff can also find links to some of the more popular conferences, **ethic courses**, free training resources, and self-study courses to purchase.
- WIC Information System Training page contains a wealth of information regarding the WIC Information System, security training, the MN WIC App, shopping with the WIC card, and reports.
 - Please refer to the <u>WINNIE Training</u> webpage for more resources on WINNIE information and training.
- **WIC Nutrition** section holds the WIC nutrition modules, Baby Behaviors, and Education Choice options for participants.
 - <u>WIC Baby Behaviors</u> provides history behind the development of the trainings, tools
 when working with participants such as the *Getting to Know Your Baby Brochure*(available in English, Spanish, and Somali), and staff trainings activities that may be
 completed alone or with a group.
- WIC Nutrition Assessment is where you will find the various tools that support staff in completing a thorough nutrition assessment for each participant type along with other resources to support staff skill development.
 - For a series of memos focused on enhancing staff skills in nutrition assessment; check out the <u>Skills Spotlight</u> to developing specific assessment skills.
- WIC Lactation Continuing Education is the spot for lactation training opportunities, including conferences, on-demand learning and webinars, and other training resources can be located on this page.
 - The USDA Breastfeeding Curriculum Training helps staff understand their roles, and how they can work together to support breastfeeding in the WIC program. Learn more about live training opportunities and self-study options.
 - The MIBFN Michigan Breastfeeding Network <u>Webinars</u> are free monthly webinars that staff can access on-demand. The trainings are available for professional continuing education credit.
