How to Register for Health Care Homes e-Learning Courses

Register for the Health Care Homes e-Learning courses by completing the following steps:

- 1. Log in to the <u>MDH Learning Center</u>. If you do not have an account, you will need to create one. There is no cost for creating an account. Leave browser open once you've logged in.
- 2. From the courses menu below, click on the registration link for the course you wish to enroll in.

- 7. After completing the course, you will receive a certificate of completion via e-mail. Submit this to your licensing board for CEU credit. Your completion certificate can be found in the Transcript section of your MDH Learning Center account.
