

# NURSE AIDE TRAINING EQUIPMENT

## Recommended list for curriculum, skills and supervised practical training

Adjustable hospital beds- up, down, elevate head of bed

(1 bed to 3 students)

(2 beds to 5-6 students)

(3 beds to 10 students)

Full mannequin(s), anatomically correct

Minimum of 3 pillows

Over the bed tray table

Nightstand

Bathing supplies, including wash basins

Liquid soap, lotion

Linens: sheets, pillowcases, bedspreads, bath blankets, towels, washcloths, hospital gowns

XL-XXL clothing: button top and bottoms for dressing

Non-skid footwear and/or non-skid socks

Scale

Handwashing sink accessibility

Bedpan (standard and fracture), urinal, toilet paper

I & O measuring devices

Alcohol wipes

Indwelling catheter supplies

Incontinent supplies: linen protectors or disposable pads, disposable briefs

Commode

Brush and comb

Call light (simulated)

Chairs (for transfers)

Clock or wristwatch with second hand

Electric razor, shaving supplies

Electronic/tympanic thermometer

Blood pressure equipment

Eyeglasses, hearing aids

Feeding equipment: clothing protector, eating utensils (dishes, silverware, disposable cups/240 ml and 120 ml), adaptive feeding supplies, meal tray with name on card, napkins

Single serve food portions for feeding skill

Disinfecting hand wipes

Isolation supplies: gloves, isolation gown, isolation bag, and soiled laundry receptacle

Mechanical lift (optional)

Nail care supplies: file, clippers

Oral hygiene supplies: denture cup, dentures (top or bottom), denture adhesive, toothbrush, toothpaste, toothette swabs, mouthwash, and emesis basin

Paper towels

Privacy curtain/screen

Three varieties of food and one beverage

Transfer belts

Walker, cane

Waste container, soiled linen hamper, trash bags

Wheelchair with footrests

Anti-embolic stockings
