New Business

Legislative updates – Over the counter hearing aid technical changes clarifying and making our state statutes consistent with the new federal rules, have been included in the Health Omnibus bill. That bill is still being negotiated. Hearing aid language does not seem to be a sticking point. The issue is keeping the nurses at the bedside act part of the bill. Once they're able to negotiate that, we will be able to move the Omnibus bill forward and our language should be incorporated is the expectation. We won't know until the bill is taken on.
