STAC Positions Open for Appointment

Applications are being accepted right now for six State Trauma Advisory Council (STAC) offices to be appointed to four-year terms beginning January 2024. This is a great opportunity to participate in Minnesota's citizen government and influence public policy.

The STAC typically meets as a full council four times each year to advise the Minnesota Commissioner of Health on a variety of matters related to improving trauma care across the state. Members also can participate in a variety of subcommittees and work groups. Applications are being accepted for the following positions:

- **Neurosurgeon- Level 1 or 2 Trauma Hospital**: a neurosurgeon certified by the American Board of Neurological Surgery who practices in a level 1 or 2 trauma hospital
- **Rural General Surgeon**: a general surgeon certified by the American Board of Surgery or the American Osteopathic Board of Surgery whose practice includes trauma and who practices in a designated rural area as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (e)
- **Rural Hospital Administrator- Level 3 or 4 Trauma Hospital**: a hospital administrator of a level 3 or 4 trauma hospital located in a designated rural area as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (e)
- Rural Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant- Level 4 Trauma Hospital: a nurse practitioner, as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (1), or a physician assistant, as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (o), whose practice includes emergency room care in a level 4 trauma hospital located in a designated rural area as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (e)
- Trauma Program Manager- Level 3 or 4 Trauma Hospital: a trauma program manager or coordinator who practices in a level 3 or 4 trauma hospital
- **Trauma Surgeon- Level 1 or 2 Trauma Hospital**: a trauma surgeon certified by the American Board of Surgery or the American Osteopathic Board of Surgery who practices in a level 1 or 2 trauma hospital

To apply for one of these positions, visit the <u>Minnesota Secretary of State's website</u>. To ensure consideration, submit your application by **November 30, 2023**.
