Pfizer for 12 years and older pre-filled syringe product change

All Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for 12 years and older ordered by the MnVFC and UUAV programs will be fulfilled with Pfizer's new refrigerated vaccine product (NDC 00069-2377-10), that comes in a carton of 10 manufacturer-filled syringes.

- This new presentation MUST be stored between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F). Do NOT store at ultra-cold or standard freezer temperatures. Boxes have a new bright pink banner with DO NOT FREEZE.
- These manufacturer-filled syringes can be used through the expiration date printed on the carton. The 10-week beyond-use date (BUD) for refrigerator storage does not apply.
- This guidance applies to this presentation ONLY. Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines for children aged 6 months to 4 years and 5 to 11 years, which are shipped to providers in CDC's programs directly from Pfizer on dry ice and can be stored at either at ultra-cold temperatures until expiry or up to 10 weeks at 2-8°C.

Plan to use up all your current Pfizer for 12 years and older vaccine until the expiration date or 10-week refrigerator BUD before switching to the new product.



FluMist® replacement program

McKesson is offering a FluMist® Quadrivalent Replacement Program for product purchased through the CDC contract for 2023-2024. This applies to MnVFC and UUAV FluMist® doses. The replacement program allows for the replacement of unused, expiring FluMist® Quadrivalent doses, at no cost, to help you maximize product usage opportunities.

Eligibility Guidelines:

- Doses must have been purchased on the CDC contract. Private doses are not eligible for the FluMist[®] Quadrivalent Replacement Program for CDC.
- Product expiration date must be on or before Feb. 2, 2024.
- AstraZeneca will replace expired doses of FluMist® Quadrivalent while supplies last.
